 - a. Northeast CoC Allocation is \$259,188.00
 - Divided 6 ways is \$43,198.00
 - · Divided 5 ways is \$51,837.60
 - · Divided 4 ways is \$64,797.00
 - b. Interested Applicants: Community Crisis Center, Hope House, SafeNet Services, Youth & Family Services, Tahleqauh Men's Shelter, Grand Lake Mental Health
 - c. Apps are due to NEOCAA & CARD on May 20th
 - d. Motion to allocate the funding for this grant evenly six ways made by Lisa Look; Katie Wilson seconded. Motion carries unanimously.
